- From now on you will only need to enter your personal username and password (if any course you have enrolled in).

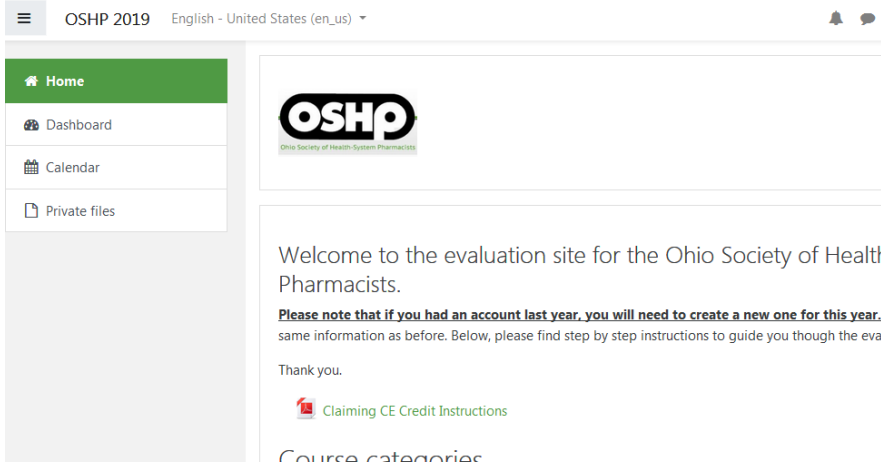

  - For the month and day of birth please enter it as MMDD. No spaces or dashes.
- You should receive an email with further directions to complete your registration.
  - You may need to check your Spam and Trash folders

- **If you do not get an email**, please contact Chandra Dunbar at [c-dunbar@onu.edu](mailto:c-dunbar@onu.edu). It be will confirmed for you.
- Once you have confirmed your account, log back into [raabecollegeofpharmacy.org/oshp/](http://raabecollegeofpharmacy.org/oshp/)
- It may take you to your dashboard which shows the courses you have enrolled in. If so, click the Home link on the Left hand side, under Navigation.



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- If needed, click the drop down arrow next to “Monday, May 6th, 2019” or “Tuesday, May 7th, 2019” to see the courses for that day

### CPE and License Renewal

According to the 2013 *Survey of Pharmacy Law*, 53 boards of pharmacy require pharmacists to participate in continuing pharmacy education (CPE) activities as a prerequisite for license renewal.

### Set up Your NABP e-Profile!

CPE Monitor, through the collaborative efforts of NABP, the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE), and ACPE providers, allows you to electronically keep track of CPE credits from ACPE-accredited providers. To view and track these credits, you must first set up an NABP e-Profile, obtain your NABP e-Profile ID, and register for CPE Monitor. You may do so by clicking on the "Log in to Your e-Profile to Access CPE Monitor" link below. ACPE-accredited providers will ask for your e-Profile ID and your date of birth in order to properly record your CPE credits through the system.
